This six-month, online certificate equips participants with the tools to inspire and prepare the next generation of medical professionals by applying evidence-based educational theories and proven teaching practices.

This six-month online certificate is designed for highly motivated faculty, lecturers, and instructors engaged in medical education seeking to develop effective classroom and clinical teaching skills. This includes clinicians, pharmacists, nurses and nurse practitioners, physician assistants, dentists, and other health care professionals teaching medical education.
